ORDINANCE 466

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 376 WHICH ESTABLISHED SINGLE MEMBER DISTRICTS FOR ELECTION OF VILLAGE COUNCILORS AND ADOPTED RULES AND REGULATIONS TO IMPLEMENT ELECTIONS BY DISTRICT AS AUTHORIZED IN 1-3-13 NMSA 1978.

WHEREAS, the Village of Los Lunas adopted Ordinance 376 in 2011 in order to establish single member districts based on the 2010 United States Census; and

WHEREAS, the 2020 United States Census determined that the Village of Los Lunas has a population of 17,242; and

WHEREAS, the population distribution within each district must be equal, with an allowable deviation of plus or minus 5%; and

WHEREAS, the Village of Los Lunas must re-district in order to comply with districting requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF THE VILLAGE OF LOS LUNAS, COUNTY OF VALENCIA, STATE OF NEW MEXICO, THAT ELECTION OF VILLAGE COUNCILORS CHAPTER 2.44 SECTION 2.44.010 PURPOSE; SECTION 2.44.020 CREATION OF DISTRICTS; AND SECTION 2.44.030 IMPLEMENTATION OF DISTRICTS, BE AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS IN ORDER TO AMEND THE DISTRICTS BASED ON THE 2020 UNITED STATES CENSUS:

2.44.010 Purpose.

The purpose of this chapter is to establish single member districts for election of village councilors, and to adopt rules and regulations to implement elections by district as authorized in 1-3-13 NMSA 1978.

2.44.020 Creation of districts.

A. Beginning with the November 2023 regular municipal election, village councilors shall reside in and be elected from municipal election districts, except as otherwise provided in this chapter.

B. There are created four municipal election districts which include the following full and partial precincts:

District One (1) – One hundred percent (100%) of precincts thirty-nine (39), forty-four (44), sixty-four (64), and sixty-five (65), and portions of precincts seventeen (17) and fifty-five (55).

District Two (2) – One hundred percent (100%) of precincts three (3), forty (40), forty-one (41), and forty-two (42), as well as precinct one (1).

District Three (3) – One hundred percent (100%) of precinct fifty-four (54), and portions of precincts twelve (12), seventeen (17), and fifty-five (55).

District Four (4) – One hundred percent (100%) of precincts two (2), five (5), ten (10), thirty-six (36), forty-three (43), and sixty-two (62), and a portion of precinct twelve (12), as well as precincts eleven (11) and nineteen (19), which have zero population.

The boundaries of each municipal election district are shown on the municipal election district map, which is hereby adopted as part of this ordinance as the official districting map, and is to be kept in the custody of the village administrator.

C. The districts created are single member districts.

2.44.030 Implementation of districting.

Hold-over councilors residing in districts two (2) and four (4) will complete the remainder of their terms. The voters in districts two (2) and four (4) shall vote for a district councilor candidate during the election held in November 2023 and every four years thereafter. The voters in districts one (1) and three (3) shall vote for a district councilor candidate during the election held in November 2025 and every four years thereafter.

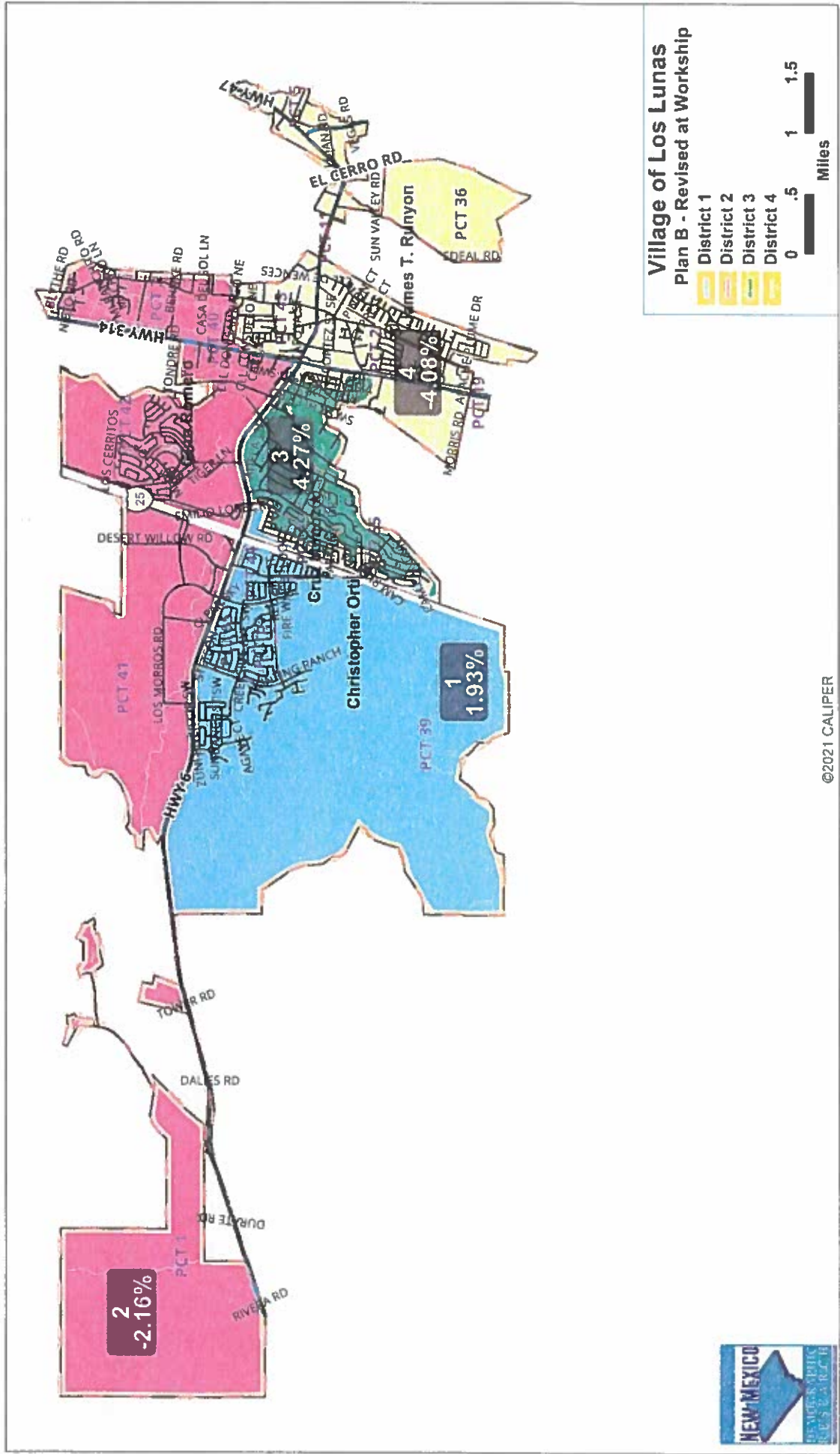

All Districts



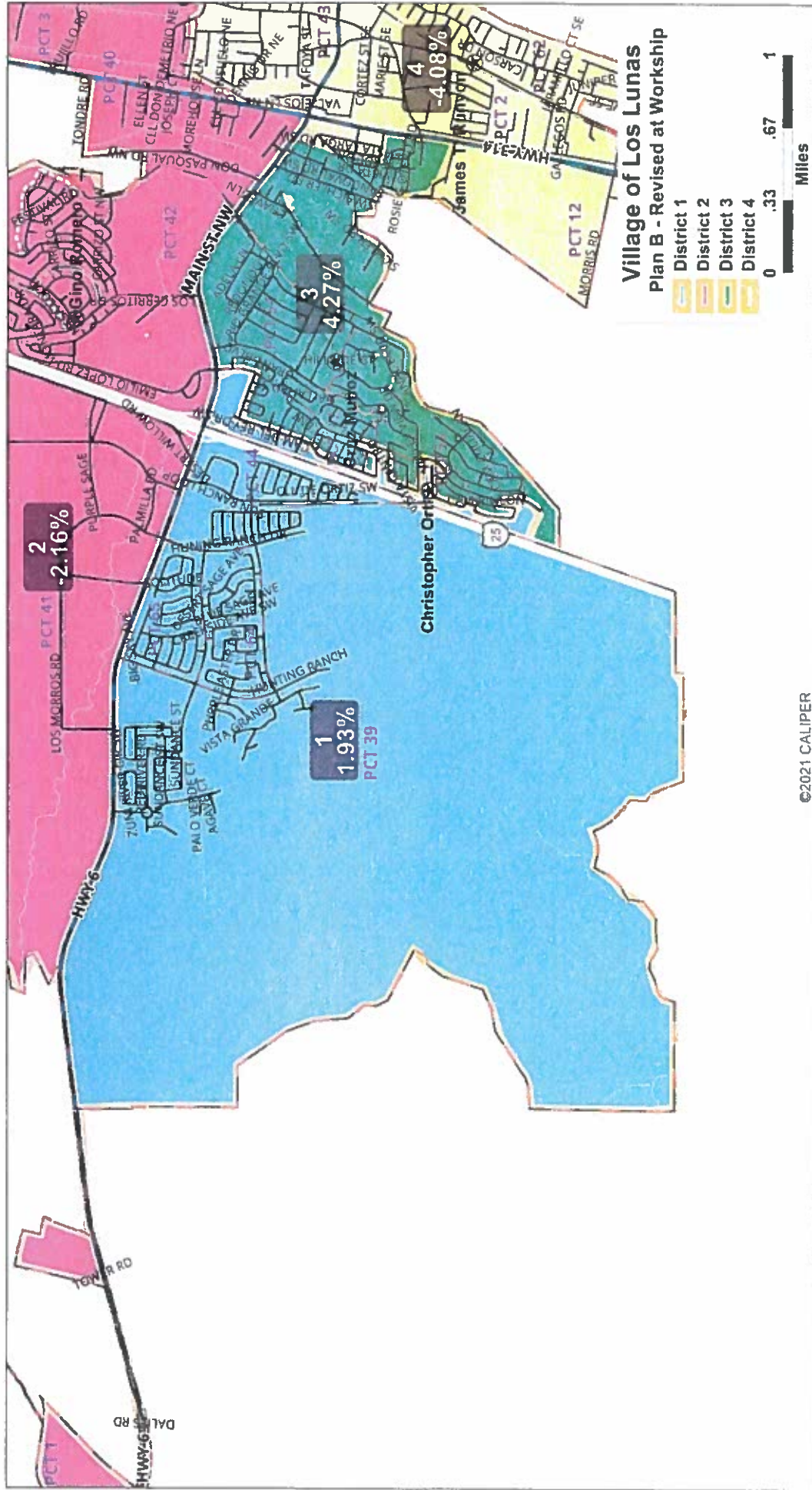

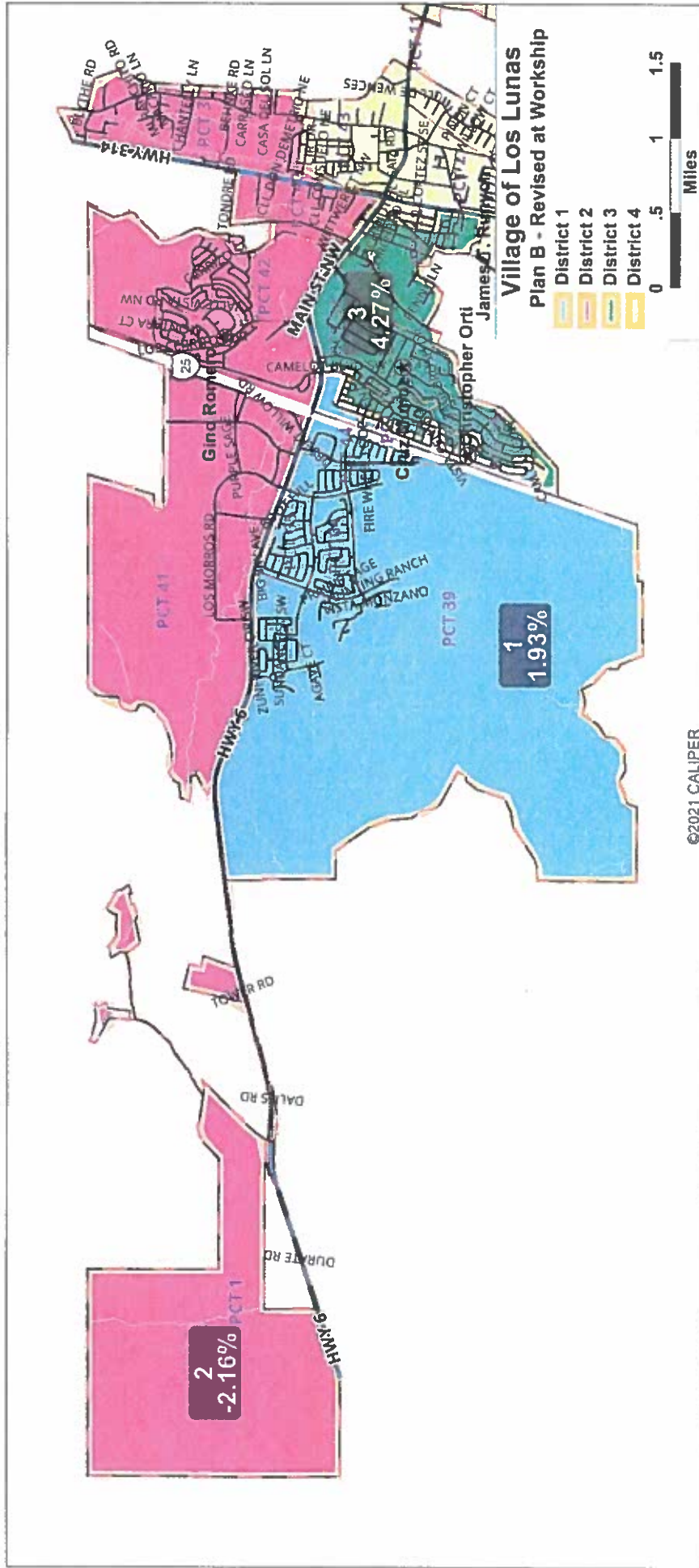


Los Lunas Plan B as Revised at the Workshop District 1

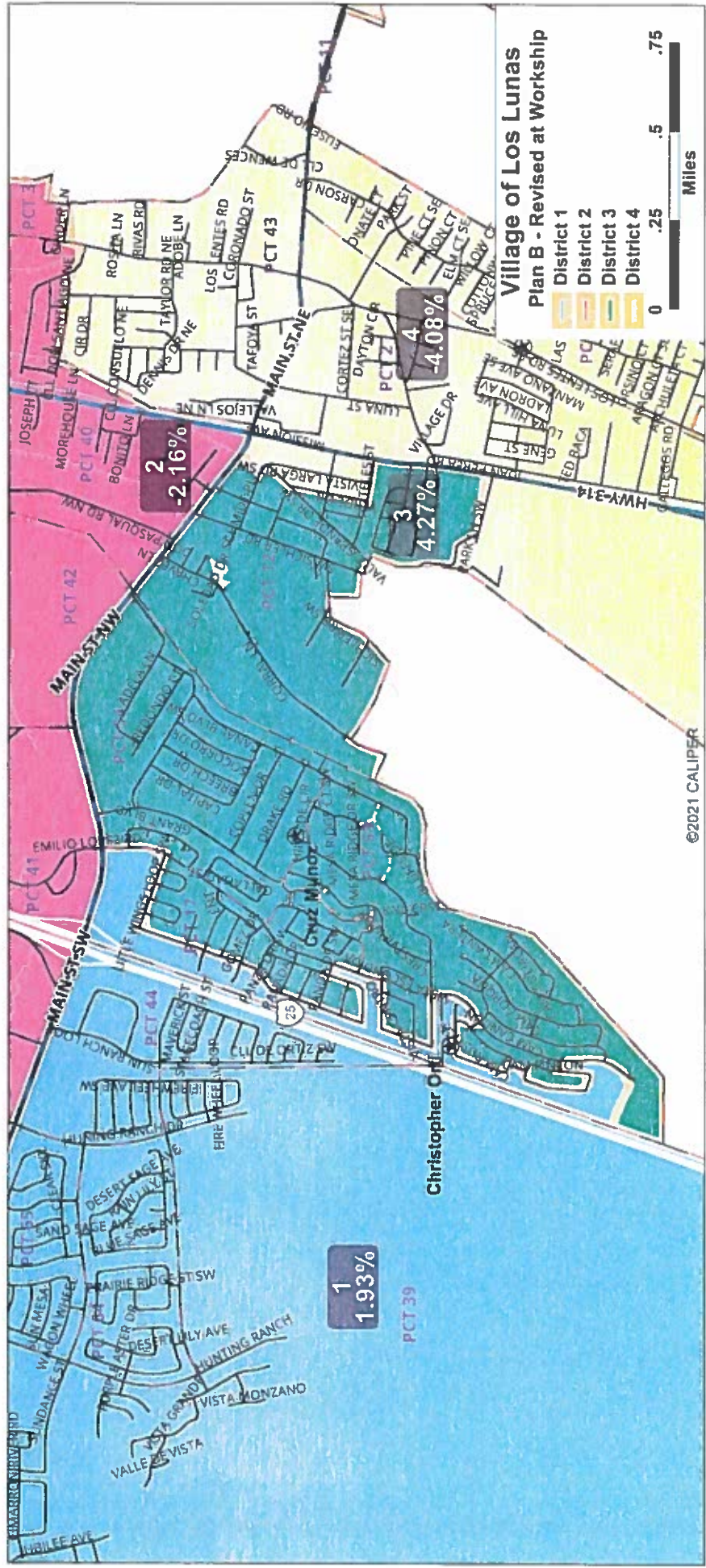

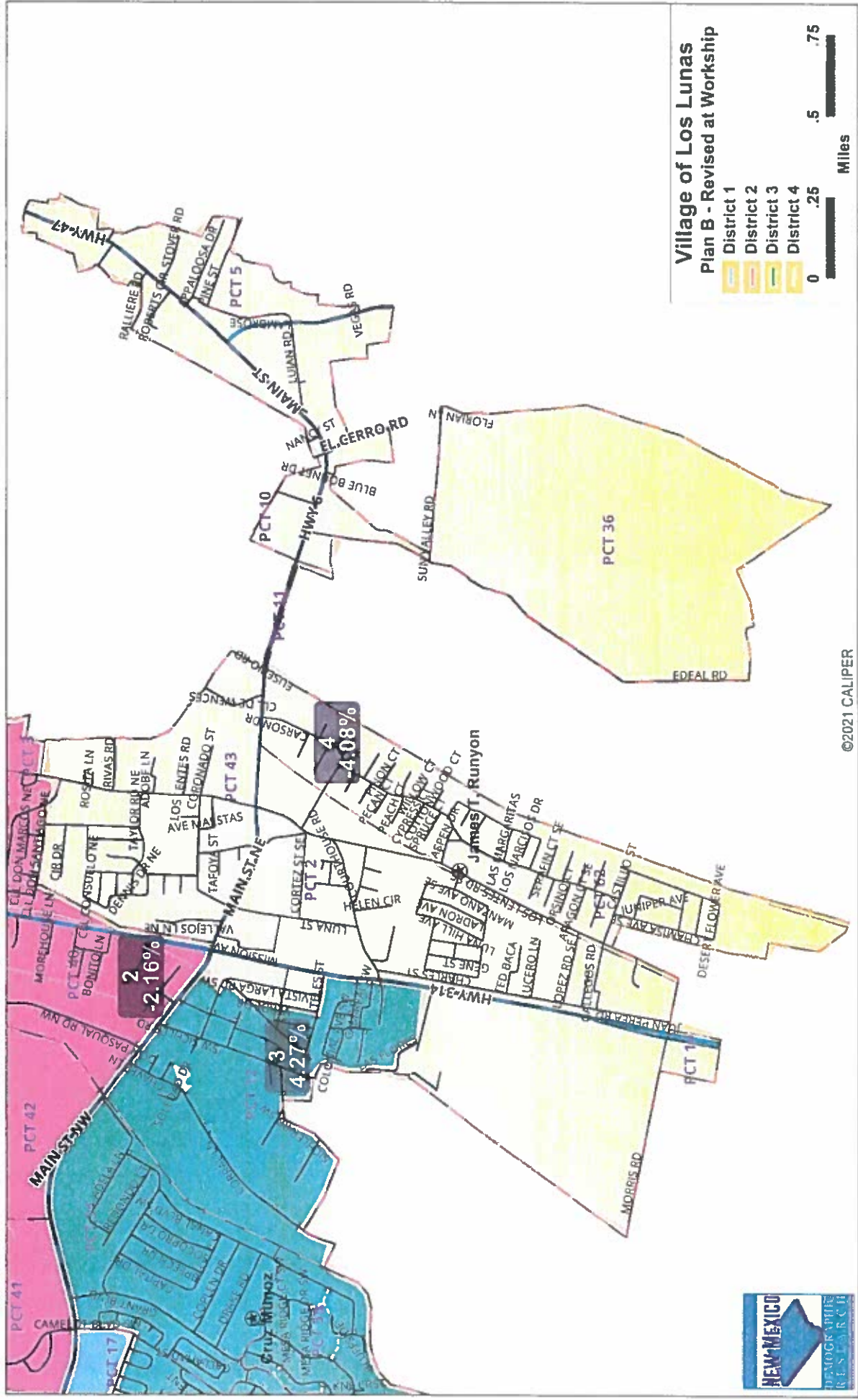
