HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHT

San Clemente Church



One of the oldest continuously active churches in Valencia County is San Clemente in Los Lunas. The original parish was built in 1876, with a newer parish being built in 1948. The current parish began to be built in 2001, and can now serve 800 to 900 Valencia County residents. San Clemente was named after Pope Clement I, the fourth Pope of Rome. The church name was to honor the bishop for his achievement in converting Romans to Christianity. Pope Clement I was martyred by being thrown into the sea with an anchor tied to his feet in AD 100.
