HISTORICAL HIGHLIGHT

Sgt. Foch Romero

Foch Romero was born August 4, 1918 in Los Lunas to Donaciano D. Romero and Barbarita Speare. Legend has it that Foch's mother, Barbarita, had a dream one night. She heard a large boom and ran outside to see what had happened. What greeted her was a huge hole that had been blown in her yard. As the smoke cleared, there on the ground near the hole was her son Foch. The next morning the family received a telegram informing them of their son's death. Technical Sergeant Foch Romero, a member of the 180th Infantry, experienced a traumatic event which ultimately resulted in the loss of his life on February 19, 1944 on the Anzio beachhead in Italy. A plaque memorializing Foch Romero is located next to the Los Lunas Middle School football field. His father, on the condition that the field be named after his son, donated the 9-acre field to the school (Trujillo, 1989).
